Ponderings for Pig Projects

Knowing how much your pig weighs, is an important part of your project, many of us do not have access to reliable scales. You can get a fairly accurate reading, by measuring your pig at the heart girth. Research at KSU has indicated that the heart girth measurement is about 98% accurate.

Using a regular cloth measuring tape, place directly behind the front legs. Place the tape snugly around the heart girth. The pig should be standing still and head should be down. Use the following chart to estimate the pig's weight.
