Eligibility:

- * Member of the MED 4-H within Jackson County for three years or more.
- * Must of submitted a 4-H record book previous 4-H year.
- * 2.5 grade point average (unweighted)
- * Graduating high school senior
- * Enrolled for 12 or more semester hours (check will be made out to college on behalf of the student). If vo-tech graduate, check will be made to individual upon receipt of expenses.

Instructions: Each application consists of this three page application form plus the following attachments:

- 1. 500 word essay (See section 3 of the application)
- 2. Transcript of high school grades. If home schooled, indicate such and provide appropriate documentation, if available.
- 3. One letter of recommendation from high school personnel (can be copied from State 4-H Scholarship application)

Staple this form and the required attachments in the upper left corner; return your completed application and attachments to the Meadowlark Extension District - Holton Office. **Applications must be received by June 1, of current 4-H year.**
